Absentee ballots are now available for the Durant Community School District Special Election to be held on Tuesday, September 11, 2018. The Cedar County Auditor's Office will mail a ballot to any registered voter in the Durant Community School District that requests one by mail. Request Forms are available from the Cedar County Auditor's Office or by downloading at www.cedarcounty.org. The request form should be sent to the Cedar County Auditor's Office, 400 Cedar Street, Tipton, IA 52772, and should include the voter's name, date of birth, signature, the address at which the voter is registered to vote and the name and date of the election (Special Election-September 11, 2018), and the address to which the ballot should be sent if different from the registration address. The pre-voter registration deadline and the last day to request an absentee ballot to be mailed is August 31, 2018 at 5:00 p.m.

Voters may designate any person of their choice to deliver their absentee ballot to the County Auditor. Voters still have the option of mailing of their ballot, postage is prepaid. To be counted, ballots delivered by mail must be postmarked no later than midnight, September 10, 2018, and received no later than September 18, 2018. Hand delivered ballots must reach the Auditor's Office no later than 8:00 p.m. (closing time of the polls) on Election Day, September 11, 2018.

Voters may also vote by absentee ballot in the Auditor's Office through September 10, 2018 at 5:00 p.m.
